HIGH SCHOOL MARIACHI

Description of Camp

The High School Mariachi Camp is open to students entering grades 9-12. Young musicians will have the opportunity to develop and improve their abilities while studying with professionals. Activities include instrument-specific classes, ensemble rehearsals, and performances. The camp culminates with a concert. Whatever the level of proficiency, all LMC campers find new challenges and opportunities and will advance in their ability!

The camp culminates with a required student performance in Bates Recital Hall.

Typical Daily Schedule

Residential campers are awoken by counselors. Campers and counselors eat breakfast as a group and then walk to the Butler School of Music together. All campers spend mornings in instructional time (rehearsals and/or sectionals). Counselors escort all campers back to the dorm for lunch.

The afternoon is spent in rehearsals. Commuter campers depart from the Music Building at 5:30 PM each night. Residential campers walk as a group to the dorm for dinner. Past evening activity have included guest speakers, mariachi jam sessions, and a visit to the Tejano Monument.

After the evening activity, campers go back to the dorm for a floor meeting and time to shower, call home, and go to sleep.

Arrival Day

Residential campers may begin checking in to the dorm at **11:00 AM**. The Jester East Residence Hall is located at **201 E 21st. St, Austin, TX 78705**.

(Commuter campers will remain at the Butler School of Music until the 2:00 p.m. audition time, at which point parents should depart.)

Parents should depart once the campers are checked into their rooms. After lunch, campers and counselors will walk to the Music Building as a group and begin the instructional portion of camp.

Commuter campers should arrive at the **Music Building at 12:30 PM**, at which time their parents may depart.

The Butler School of Music is located at **2406 Robert Dedman Drive**, near the corner of Robert Dedman and Dean Keeton. You may park along Dean Keeton and walk over or in the San Jacinto Parking Garage (a fee applies).

Schedule for Commuter Campers

On Sunday, commuter campers will report to the **Butler School of Music at 12:30 PM** to meet their counselors. **Evening pickup time 5:30 PM** at Winship Circle (300 E. 23rd St., Austin, TX 78712).

Beginning Monday morning, commuter campers should arrive at the Butler School of Music at 8:30 AM (drop-off point is the **steps of the Texas Memorial Museum** on Trinity St.). In case of rain, enter and remain near the main doors of the music building. Campers must check in with their counselor upon arrival and departure. Parents are asked to remain with camper until counselor is present at 8:30 AM.

Camp Concerts

All camps culminate with a student performance in Bates Recital Hall. All performances are free and open to the public. All campers must participate in the final performance. **Live webcasts of camp closing concerts will unfortunately not be possible during the summer of 2020 due to facility renovations.**

Campers will check out of their dorm rooms with their counselors on Wednesday morning (last day of camp) between 8:00 and 8:30 AM. Luggage will be stored and transported to the Butler School of Music until 30 minutes after the completion of the concert. Campers will need to bring instruments and trajes with them upon departing the dorm for their morning rehearsal.
