HIGH SCHOOL MARIACHI

Description of Camp

The High School Mariachi Camp is open to students entering grades 9-12. Young musicians will have the opportunity to develop and improve their abilities while studying with professionals. Activities include instrument-specific classes, ensemble rehearsals, and performances. The camp culminates with a concert. Whatever the level of proficiency, all LMC campers find new challenges and opportunities and will advance in their ability!

The camp culminates with a required student performance in Bates Recital Hall.

Typical Daily Schedule

Residential campers are awoken by counselors. Campers and counselors eat breakfast as a group and then walk to the Butler School of Music together. All campers spend mornings in instructional time (rehearsals and/or sectionals). Counselors escort all campers back to the dorm for lunch.

The afternoon is spent in rehearsals. Commuter campers depart from the Music Building at either 5:15 p.m. or 8:30pm each night. Residential campers walk as a group to the dorm for dinner. Past evening activities have included guest speakers, mariachi jam sessions, and a visit to the Tejano Monument.

After the evening activity, campers go back to the dorm for a floor meeting and time to shower, call home, and go to sleep.

Arrival Day

Residential campers may begin checking in to the dorm at **11:00 a.m.** The Jester West Residence Hall is located at **201 E 21st St, Austin, TX 78705.**

Parents should depart once the campers are checked into their rooms. After lunch, campers and counselors will walk to the Music Building as a group and begin the instructional portion of camp.
